Do you want to give back to football in the Sutherland Shire and get paid for doing it?

Over the age of 14 or turning 14 before April?

THEN BECOME A FOOTBALL REFEREE IN 2012 AND REFEREE MATCHES IN THE SUTHERLAND SHIRE

To become a referee you must attend one full day theory course, pass the multiple choice theory exam on the same day and then attend one half day practical course.

First year referees in 2011 who refereed just one game on a Saturday and refereed one game and ran one line on a Sunday for 18 weekends would have received a cheque of around \$1,000 (tax free) at the end of the season, easily covering the costs of the courses. Experienced referees can earn even more.
